- the gymnasium at Crestwood Elementary School
- the fund raising effort to establish the South Oldham Fire Department and Rescue Squad
- the funding and formation of the South Oldham Water District #1
- the Bucks for Books program to purchase children's books for the South Oldham Branch of the Oldham County Library
- building the sidewalk along SR 146 that links Pewee Valley and Crestwood
- building the “Lions Den” for the South Oldham Little League at Peggy Baker Park and continuing to support it

Currently, the South Oldham Lions are involved in many other community projects including:

- providing eye care and glasses for needy people
- collecting eye glasses via boxes placed in local businesses
- supporting the Kentucky Lions Eye Foundation
- providing eye screenings for children and adults at the State Fair

- supporting Lions Camp Crescendo in Lebanon Junction, Ky.
- the purchase and installation of automatic electronic defibrillators in Oldham County Schools.
- sponsoring Little League teams
- supporting Dollars for Scholars in Oldham County
